'A reference hospital of regional interest' remarkably placed at the confluence of three major roads, the CHSF blends in with the countryside like a development of a human dimension and offers 1,000 hospital beds spread over four sub hospitals.

The flexibility and ease of upgrading expected by the premises deemed architectural on the surface is spread over six storeys and offers a modular layout which is organised around wide inner courtyards offering a wealth of possible views and natural lighting.

Soundproofed, linear and heat-efficient in its design placed alongside the southern Francilienne, the architecture is home-from-home to the north and mainly overlooks the foliage of urban parkland towards which the accommodation units face the gardens around the site appearing to blot out the streets.
