bdpgroupe6 are designing a new hospital building in Tbilisi Georgia. The new building is to be built on the campus of the existing National Republic Hospital, which is the principal teaching hospital of the country; which it will substantially replace. The existing building will in turn become, the Tbilisi University Medical school as part of an overall strategy for improving medical services in the country.

bdpgroupe6 with Arup, prepared a masterplan, feasibility study and designs for the project between July and September 2008. As well as general acute hospital facilities there is an adjoining building which will contain research laboratories.

The design of the building is intended to be highly sustainable using appropriate technologies, but also designed and built to the best of Western European standards, with the latest medical technology.
